We discussed the meaning of a 'chain reaction and ripple effect' across the school and how special one kind word can be in changing how someone feels. We carried out a whole school ripple of smiles and the classes all took part in lots of different activities including joining a live lesson, designing anti-bullying posters and odd sock designing. I am looking forward to seeing all the children who have been given a 'caught being kind' card in Friday's celebration assembly.

FLU CATCH UP CLINICS

Please see the attached letter with information about Community Clinics for those that missed the main school **FLU** session.

- Year F In Foundation this week we have been taking part in anti-bullying week and trying to find ways to be kind to others. We had a great class discussion and sorted some scenarios into 'kind' or 'unkind', the children were very good at recognising these. We have read stories about characters showing kindness, like The Smartest Giant in Town, Dogger, and Bloom to explore the theme further. The children enjoyed the friendship activities we have been doing and loved making their own odd sock puppets there were some fabulous creations. In phonics we have been practicing our new sounds and learning even more new ones and in maths we have been focusing on the number 5.
- Year 1 This week we have been celebrating Anti-Bullying week. We all spoke about what being kind looks like and how it makes us feel when people are not kind. The children have been on the lookout for others being kind and they have written special tickets to the children they spotted showing kind behaviours. In maths we have been looking at odd and even numbers, using pairs of shoes to help us!
- Year 2 In Year 2 we have been thinking about kindness throughout anti-bullying week. We have thought carefully about kind words, kind actions and spreading kindness. It has been lovely to 'catch' so much kindness within Team Tigers and we will be sharing all the kind words and actions we have observed in Friday's Celebration Assembly. In maths, we have been working on subtraction and we finished working on Beegu in Guided Reading this week too.
- Year 3 In Year 3 we have had a very busy week this week. We have spent a lot of our time looking at anti-bullying week, we have particularly enjoyed creating a chain of kindness socks and the live lesson which lots of children all across the UK took part in. We thought it was amazing that we were learning at the same time as so many children. In English and our guided reading sessions we have continued to look at Stone Age Boy. We have been working on writing our own start to the story in the style of the author of the story.
- Year 4 have been busy this week learning how to add 3 and 4 digit numbers where we need to exchange. We used the place value counters to help us and are getting used to needing to exchange into the next column to get the right answer. In English we have been writing setting descriptions about our story 'Escape from Pompeii' and have learnt the importance of good verb choices. We have also spent a lot of time this week thinking about Anti Bullying week and the idea of 'one kind word'. We were all able to have some great discussions about what to do if we see someone being unkind and designed some posters which are displayed around school.

- **Year 5** In Year 5 this week we have made anti-bullying posters and made anti-bullying odd socks! In English we have been learning about devices authors use to write effective descriptions. In maths we have been multiplying and dividing numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. We have also enjoyed taking part in a hockey lesson with the PE coach.
- Year 6 This week, Year 6 have been exploring different number types in maths such as squared, cubed and prime. In English, we have been exploring the imagery writers use to try and have an impact on their reader and set a scene. In science, we have explored the term evolution and looked at Darwin's theory and in geography we have investigated how ocean currents can have an influence on climate.
