Dear Parents and Carers,

We are getting very excited in school to celebrate our 50th birthday on the week beginning 20th June. On Tuesday 21st June (12.45-3pm) we will be welcoming families to join us in a picnic afternoon on the field. A poster with all the details of the afternoon will be sent home soon. - Year F** This week in Foundation we have loved sharing our half term news, talking about all the wonderful Jubilee celebrations the children attended and the adventures of their half term holidays. We've started our new theme of pirates, sharing what we already know and discussing what we would like to find out. We're looking forward to adventures at sea this term! We've also been practicing hard for sports day and loved joining in with the tennis day.
- Year 1** In Year 1 this week the children have been working super hard showing off their phonics skills! In science we have started to learn about the weather and thinking about what clothing we need during the different weather conditions we see in England. The children really enjoyed their tennis festival on Wednesday and worked really hard to learn some new skills!

- Year 2** In Year 2 we have worked incredibly hard on our class assembly and we were exceptionally proud to share all our learning with you all. We have enjoyed making our vehicle designs come to life this week and have ensured they all have fully operational wheels and axles. In English, we have been retelling The Wizard of Oz in our own words whilst making sure we are using a range of interesting punctuation.
- Year 3** This week Year 3 have absolutely loved going swimming every day, we have worked really hard and have already made so much progress with our swimming. We have been looking at measurement and perimeter in maths and revising converting cm to m and cm to mm.
- Year 4** Year 4 have had a busy first week back. In English we have been exploring our new story called The Lost Thing. Firstly we made some great predictions about what we thought the story might be about and then we have learnt it using story telling, story mapping and story stepping. Ask us to tell you the story to see how much we can remember! In maths we have been linking our work about fractions to our new work on decimals. We have focused on tenths and hundredths and how they can be represented. We have also been practising our times tables lots! In PE we have really enjoyed learning some new tennis skills during our tennis roadshow session and we have also begun to explore our new theme of 'Cracking Contraptions' in our humanities lessons.
- Year 5** In Year 5 we have started learning about the Ancient Greeks in history. We have also started our new writing unit linked to Greek Myths. In maths we are continuing to think deeply about fractions. We are looking forward to sharing our work with you next Thursday in our class assembly!
- Year 6** This week Year 6 have been very busy on their bike ability training. In the mornings they have also been learning about the life of Shakespeare and what it was like at the Globe theatre. They have begun their science topic on light.
