
Do also have a look at the BBC Bitesize website for additional resources to accompany these Whiterose lessons. They will give you an additional activity on the same subject.

English

Our topic for the first half of this term would have been based around a book called The Lost Thing by the author Shaun Tan, so one of your English tasks this week is to research the author Shaun Tan. Have you ever read any of his books? What can you find out about his style? Can you create a fact page all about him?



Look at the front and back covers of the book (I've attached a large copy on the website). What do you think about the book? Complete the worksheet about it

with – what do you **observe**, **wonder** and **infer** about the book just based on the front and back cover.

Other subject areas

Topic – inc Science and DT This week we are going to focus on the history of the invention of flight / the aeroplane.

Task 1 – Research the history of the invention of mechanical flight and then create an information leaflet, poster or Powerpoint about it.

Task 2 – research The Wright brothers. Why were they so important in the development of mechanical flight. Can you create a fact file about them?

Task 3 - watch a clip of the Wright Brother's first flight. Then write a newspaper report about what happened that day. Try to include a good headline and some quotes.

Task 4- imagine you are one of the Wright brothers. Write a letter to your mum and dad about what has happened that day.

Task 5 – have a paper aeroplane making competition in your family. Who can make the 'best' design? How are you

As before half term, if you would like something a little different then have a look at the <u>I See Maths Website</u>. This is a resource we use in school and they are also providing daily lessons. These are more problem solving based so should add a bit of variety to Maths work.
