Class News

- Year F In Foundation this week we have loved performing in our KS1 Christmas performances for a real audience! All of those practices paid off and we loved showing the parents our play. We also had the great experience of watching actors on stage in the pantomime on our school trip. In between all the theatrics we've learned some new sounds in phonics and continued thinking about parts and wholes in maths.
- Year 1 We have had a busy week in Year 1! We are so proud of how well the children performed in their Nativity on Monday and Tuesday. They all sang beautifully! The children had such a wonderful time watching Jack and the Beanstalk on Wednesday! They were very well behaved and were a joy to take out.
- Year 2 We have been comparing the modes of transport used in India and England and we have been thinking about the type of environment each of these modes are used in and why. In maths we have been using wooden Rekenreks to support us with our recall of number facts and our understanding of number patterns. Our Key Stage 1 Nativity was a highlight for us all and we loved performing to an audience.
- Year 3 Year 3 have had a very busy week. This week in English we have been finishing our writing about Stone Age Boy. We have worked really hard on this and we have written lovely adventure stories. We have tried to include all of the different things that we have learnt throughout the term! We have also been practicing the performance lots and we are very excited for all of you to come and see all our hard work. We really enjoyed our trip to watch the panto too it was such a brilliant show and we had a fabulous time.
