# **Coronavirus and isolation over Christmas**

Staff have been trying extra hard to keep themselves and the children safe this week, with Christmas only 8 days away! Please read the following information carefully as I will need to be made aware if a positive case occurs after the school has closed. I am praying that I do not need to send any information asking families to isolate over the Christmas holidays!

School closes at either 12pm or 12.10pm for all children on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December. If your child develops any symptoms of Covid within the 48hr time period after leaving school on the Friday (BEFORE 12pm on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> December) and then tests positive, school will need to contact families from the affected bubble.

If your child develops symptoms and tests positive after the 48hr period, please use the 119 NHS advice line and follow the staying at home guidance.

I will try and sum this information up in a table:

My child develops symptoms of Covid before 12.10pm on Sunday 20 <sup>th</sup> December	Book a test  If the test is positive –inform the school asap, email school on office.2583@stockham.sch.uk. School will then carry out track and trace.  If the test is negative –you can carry on as normal
My child develops symptoms after Sunday 12pm	Book a test  If the test is positive, email school. School will not need to ask anyone to isolate as this is after the 48hr period  You will however need to call 119 and follow the isolate at home guidance above.
My child has a positive test after 6 days of leaving school	Do not email school. Ring 119 and follow the advice set.  School will not be answering emails after 12pm on Christmas Eve so that they can have some well-deserved family time.
