Dear Parents and Carers.

I am so pleased to confirm the Government's announcement earlier this week that school will be returning to 'normal' in September.

Please note, the following could be subject to change if guidelines and rules change over the summer holidays



This news brings with it many exciting changes. From the 6th September:

- School for all children will start at 8.40am and finish at 3.05pm
- School bubbles will no longer be needed and children will be able to play and learn together again.
- Face coverings both inside school and in the playground will be a personal choice.
- After school clubs can open up to more children.
- Whole school assemblies can take place in the hall.
- Classes will not need to isolate if there is a child or adult with a confirmed positive Coronavirus
  case (however, parents and carers will be informed if this does happen)
- The one way system will not need to be strictly followed, but please be courteous to other adults
  when dropping off and picking up your child/ren (especially adults who wish to continue wearing
  a face covering.

School will be continuing to hand wash /sanitise regularly, carry out additional cleaning and continue with increased respiratory hygiene. Please can I ask that children still do not go on the play equipment before or after school as the school are held responsible for any accidents that may take place due to lack of supervision from parents.
