

Class News

- Year F In Foundation this week we have been thinking about the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears, with some interesting discussions about Goldilocks' actions in the story. We talked about how she could make amends and have been busy learning how to make porridge, fix chairs and design new bed covers for Baby Bear! In maths we have been thinking about the number 7 and exploring the other numbers that are in it.
- Year 1 In Year 1 this week we have started to write our fact pages about Queen Elizabeth II, the children have been using their research to help them. As the weather has been so lovely the children have enjoyed being out in the garden lots this week. One of the independent learning activities outside, was observational paintings of a bunch of daffodils, some of the children have really enjoyed this and have experimented with different ways of using the water colours. The children really enjoyed our arty afternoon, creating their mother days gifts, cards, and paper flower bunches.
- Year 2 In Year 2 we have been adding pounds and pence in our maths lessons. We have worked hard on using what we know about adding ones to help us add the large tens coins. Some of us have been able to add very large totals of money! In our computing lessons we have continued with our unit on Coding. We have become experts at using loops to give instructions as efficiently and concisely as we can.
- Year 3 This week, in English, Year 3 have been carrying on with our instruction writing unit we have been learning how to use bullet points and brackets, we have also been using positive adjectives, alliteration adverbials and complex sentences to make our instructions exciting to read. In maths we are carrying on with our 4 times tables, we are working on remembering them out of sequence and using our multiplication knowledge to divide too. We are also really enjoying finding out about lots of the different European countries that we are 'neighbours' with, we have been looking at languages spoken, currency used and different countries flags.

- Year 4 have been busy this week making predictions about how our story The Lion and the Unicorn might end. We have written our own endings and are looking forward to seeing how close we are to the real one. In maths we have begun to look at division and have found the place value counters can really help us with this area of learning. We have also needed to use our knowledge of exchange to help us when the counters could not be evenly shared. As historians we have looked at different sources of evidence about the past and thought about how this could tell us different things about World War II.
- Year 5 This week Year 5 have continued writing their persuasive letter in English all about child labour. In maths we have completed an investigation on perimeter. We have also begun reading the Anglo-Saxon story of Beowulf and enjoyed carrying out some drama activities this week linked to the text. We have learned about how to separate materials in science, using sieving, filtering, and evaporation.
- **Year 6** This week Year 6 have begun to explore fractions, decimals and percentages and find connections between them. In English we have started to explore narrative after completing AMAZING heart explanation texts. In history, we have continued to explore how society has changed over time in the context of medicine.
