Dear Visitor/volunteer,

We are currently allowing visitors and volunteers to come into school. This may include visitors for safeguarding, behaviour, Educational support, Special Needs, or other visitors arranged and approved by the Head Teacher.

We ask that you refrain from visiting if:

- you have developed a temperature, have a new, continuous cough or have a changed or loss in taste or smell within the last 10 days.

Along with all members of the Stockham School, any visitors to the School should wash their hands/sanitise on arrival and before exiting the school. Gel hand sanitiser will be available on arrival in the main reception area and throughout your visit at various points around the school.

We request that 'one off' visitors or visitors who are not regularly part of our school community wear a face covering for signing in on arrival and when travelling around the school building. Please ensure you have washed/sanitised your hands before using the electronic sign in system.

If you are visiting to meet with children (social workers, Educational Psychologist or other essential professionals, we ask that you follow more detailed guidelines sent by our SENCO linked to working safely with children in our school.

For the avoidance of potential embarrassment, we would also like to advise you that the School is currently still operating a 'no handshake' policy for all members of its community.

There may be some classes who are operating in a 'bubble' due to confirmed Covid19 cases and may be temporarily unable to have new visitors. We apologise if this causes any disappointment.

We ask that you contact the school if, within 48 hours after your last visit, **you** develop symptoms of coronavirus or test positive for Covid19 so that leaders in school can take appropriate action.
