Below are the stories of four talented musicians, whose music continues to inspire many people today.



Ella Fitzgerald

Ella Fitzgerald was born in Virginia, USA in 1917. Her career lasted for over 60 years. She was called the 'First Lady of Jazz' and people liked her fantastic voice. Ella wanted to be a dancer when she was a child. When she was 17 years old, she panicked just as she was about to dance on stage at a contest. She chose to sing instead. She won first prize. During her career, she won 14 awards. In 1966, she became the first woman to receive a lifetime achievement award from a famous recording academy.




Aretha Franklin

Aretha Franklin was born in Tennessee, USA in 1942. Many people think that Aretha is the greatest soul singer in the history of **R & B** music. She first began performing as a young child when she would play the piano and sing with her father. Over her impressive career, she won 20 awards, including one for lifetime achievement. Aretha used her fame to raise awareness of causes that were important to her, such as healthcare and the environment.



Bob Marley






Stormzy

Stormzy was born on 26th July 1993. His real name is Michael Omari and he is from Croydon, London. Stormzy is a rapper who makes **grime** music. His first album was the first grime album to reach number one in the British album chart.

Stormzy began his career by posting videos online. In 2019, he helped two Black students to afford to attend university. He wanted to remind young Black people that they could have the future that they wanted.




Aretha Franklin

Stormzy, or Michael Omari, was born on 26th July 1993 in Croydon, London. He is a British rapper who makes **grime** music. His debut album was the first grime album to make it to number one in the British album chart. In 2018, he also won British album of the year at an awards ceremony.

Stormzy began his by career posting videos online. In 2019, Stormzy provided funding for two Black students to attend a prestigious British university. He said that he chose to support the students to remind young Black people that the opportunity to study at some of the best universities in the country was available to them and that they too could achieve their dreams.


