Dear Parents and Carers,

- Year F In Foundation this week we have been learning more about pirates, what they wear and why they look the way they do. We enjoyed our history lesson about real pirates who lived 300 years ago and have been busy designing our own pirate outfits. We've been working hard practicing our key stage and whole school songs and are sounding really great! We can't wait to have a real audience next week!
- Year 1 This week in Year 1 we have been very busy learning the different songs to sing to the parents next week at the Birthday Picnic! In English we have been looking at stories by Ed Vere.
