PRIMARY SCHOOL CAKE-TOP COMPETITION

The children have come home from school today with a cake topper design. Please hand these in to the class teachers by the 18th April. Maybe one of the children from Stockham will see their design come to life as a real cake? (see below)

As part of the Town's Celebration of The Coronation of His Majesty The King and Her Majesty The Queen Consort, on Saturday 6th May 2023, the Market Place will be closed and a large screen to display the Coronation installed. There will be tables and chairs laid out, food and drink stalls, a stage with musical entertainment, and various children's rides and family entertainment.

As part of the celebrations, two large cakes (28" by 14" / 71 cm by 35 cm) are being baked professionally. One cake will have the Coronation logo, see below; the other will have a design created by a local primary school pupil. Stockham School will hold its own competition and submit 2 winning designs from each appropriate year group. These designs will then be judged and the overall winner's design put onto the cake. The Winner and Runners' up will be displayed in the Vale and Downland Museum and will be given Coronation related prizes and certificates.

Class News

- Year F In Foundation class this week we have been making more observations of the chicks

 they have inspired our writing and our artwork! We have practiced hard for our assembly, and looked forward to showing off our work to parents and the rest of the school. We also had an Easter based class treat for getting to 10 gemstones in our jar, which was a great fun way to finish the term.
- Year 1 This week in Year 1 we finished our pigeon books and we were able to share them with foundation class which was great fun! We have thought more about natural structures this week and we have created some nests and decorated some eggs.
- Year 2 This week Year 2 have created their 'playground games' book ready to show Year 1. We have started to look at multiplication and division in maths. In DT, we have created leaver and slider mechanisms - making moving pictures after we practised with prototypes.
- Year 3 We have had an amazing week! We have finished our reports on the finding of Tutankhamun's Tomb in English. While on our trip yesterday, the children showed just how knowledgeable they were of King Tutankhamun. Yesterday, the children had an awesome time at the museum! In the morning we toured the museum in our groups looking for different artefacts from Ancient Egyptian and the Iron Age period. In the afternoon we became Egyptian Detectives looking for clues. The children liked the mummy of Djeddjehutyiewefankh. They had great fun pronouncing his name! Just a reminder about upcoming events. During the summer terms we will be running Forest School for year 3. Please check your child's letter (sent out on 28.03.2023) regarding the dates your child will be participating in Forest School. There are two groups.
- Year 4 This week Year 4 have been excited to end their term with some sessions making Easter crafts. They all took great care in making sure they were the best they could be. They have also continued their progress in maths, this week identifying equivalent fractions using a number line. During PE they demonstrated their skills in Netball, playing short games against each other.
- Year 5 Year 5 have had a very busy end to the term. We have completed our maths unit on multiplication and completed our assessment. We have also started planning fact files in English. We had a fantastic day on Wednesday with our Anglo Saxon day! We learnt about the Witan, Anglo Saxon battles and we completed an archaeological dig! The children were really well behaved and a credit to Stockham. Well done Year 5!
- Year 6 Year 6 have been busy this week completing our work on our book The Last Bear. We have written our own story of how Bear got to the island and thought about how climate change has affected the life of Bear and the conditions on the island. We were determined to get the book finished before the holiday so we could see what happened to Bear and April. In maths we have been learning about perimeter and area and have now learnt how to work out the area of a triangle using a formula. In geography we have been learning about climate change: what causes it and how we might be able to prevent it. We have also been very busy making our Easter crafts ready for the Key Stage 2 Easter Fayre. We have all worked very hard this term and are looking forward to the Easter holidays!
