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
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House System

The children absolutely loved taking part in our House System last year and we are excited to get this underway again. Like last year, we look forward to awarding pupils who earn House Points for demonstrating positive learning behaviours. As we have used birds of prey as our class names, we have chosen trees for our houses as this will support some of our learning across the curriculum. All pupils are included within a house team the children will stay in the same colour group and if you are at all unsure of your child's team (particularly if they are new to our school), please check with your child's class teacher.



Attendance

Good attendance is so important in supporting all children to achieve their full potential so please try to ensure your child attend's school each day. We will be monitoring attendance closely to ensure our pupils maximise all learning opportunities available to them. In the unfortunate event that they are too unwell to attend school, please contact the school office to report this.

You can inform us by telephone on 01235 764407. Please ensure that you give a reason for your child's absence. If we do not hear from you, then we will phone all of your emergency contact numbers until we make contact. If we are not able to make contact with anyone, then



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we may need to contact other agencies to carry out a welfare check. Your cooperation with this is greatly appreciated – it is a vital part of our safeguarding procedures.

Absence Requests

Please remember that holidays in term-time will not be authorised as regulations only allow Headteacher's to authorise absence (leave) in 'exceptional circumstances.' An 'exceptional circumstance' would have to be defined as an unavoidable cause, e.g. a one-off emergency situation which prevents the child from attending school.

Family holidays, for whatever reason, cannot be approved, even if the parent is unable to take time off work at any other time. Requests for holidays in term time will not be authorised, and holidays which are unauthorised should not be taken. If they are taken, parents are in breach of their legal duty to ensure that their child attends school full time. If the absence is not authorised and the holiday is taken anyway, the case may be referred to the Local Authority Attendance Service who may issue a Penalty Notice to each parent for each child taken out of school.

Parking Plea

Thank you to the vast majority of our parent community who continue to park considerately, responsibly and safely. We believe our school is a vital and valued part of our school community and we want local residents to feel the same. Please be mindful of our neighbours when collecting and dropping off your children by car. In the interests of our children's safety, the school car park is only to be used for staff so that cars are not moving on the school grounds when the children are arriving or leaving the site.

Reminders

Naming school uniform

We have so many jumpers, cardigans and sweatshirts left outside after lunchtime and playtime, without names on. Please can you name (even if it is with a biro), your child's name or initials onto items that they take off regularly. We cannot return items, if we do not know whose it is.

Water Bottles & Coats

Just a quick reminder that children are encouraged to bring their own water bottle into school labelled with their name. They are able to keep their water bottle in class to use to stay



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hydrated. Please also remember to provide a warm/ waterproof coat for your child. Many thanks for your continued support.

Year 6 Secondary School Transfer

OCC must receive applications for secondary school places by 31 October 2024 and letters will be sent home with our Y6 pupils. Local secondary schools will hold open days and open evenings and families always find it useful to attend such events. These are often advertised on the schools' websites. If you wish to take your child on a school visit please let the school office know either in writing or by phone and please remember to book a school meal in advance should your child require one.

Please ensure that your application, whether made electronically or on paper, is made no later than the closing date of 31st October 2024. This is extremely important as any applications received after this date will not be considered until after 1st March 2025. Parents are encouraged to apply on line wherever possible as this will ensure that they are aware that their application has been received.

Free School Meal Eligibility

We would strongly urge parents who believe their child may be entitled to a free school meal to apply, even if their child is currently in Reception or Key Stage 1 and already receives free school meals as part of the universal offer. Schools receive additional funding for each pupil eligible for FSM. This funding is used by the school to provide additional services to support your child.

Finally, on behalf of the staff and I, we are excited to begin a new school year with you and your children and very much look forward to working with you to ensure that we have another successful year together at Stockham Primary School. If you have any concerns regarding the start to the year and your child settling, please see your child's class teacher or pop into the Office.
