Class News

- Year F** In Foundation this week we had a visit from the NHS dental nurse who explained the importance of oral health. The children were taught how to take care of their teeth and mouth by understanding how long they should be brushing their teeth for and when to visit the dentist. The children consolidated their learning by having fun brushing giant teeth in the classroom! As a group we also made some classroom rules, why not see if your child can explain to you what some of these are at home? The children have been busy starting to read in school this week and have also learnt the sounds 'i', 'n', 'm', 'd'. In maths we have been busy building our counting skills to 5, we learned how important it is to be careful when we are counting one by one and ways that can help us to do this.
- Year 1** This week in Year 1 we have learnt more about our 5 senses focusing on hearing and learning about how sound vibrates through the air. In English we have started creating a story board based on the story of The Colour Monster goes to School, we have enjoyed acting out our first day of school and how we were feeling.
- Year 2** Year 2 have begun a new story in English: Eliot the Midnight Hero. We have had great fun learning how different types of sentence can make the story more entertaining to read aloud. We have had a go at writing our own exclamations and remembered to use the exclamation mark in our writing. The superhero theme has continued in art as we have been using bright Pop Art colours to make a repeated image of a superhero different each time it is printed. In maths, we have been estimating where best to place different numbers on number lines that have different intervals.
- Year 3** This week Year 3 have been planning their own Stone Age story in English and have continued learning about place value in maths. In our music lesson this week we acted out a story to match a piece of music. In history, we learned about different types of Stone Age homes.
- Year 4** This week in Year 4 we have been learning about the key features of a paragraph. The children used this knowledge to rewrite the story of Escape from Pompeii, along with storymaps from last week. In maths we have been looking at adding or taking away 1, 10 or 100 from a number. The children used the place value counters to help them understand how to borrow and exchange. In PE we have been doing gymnastics, the children have been looking at different balances and have put them together to create a small routine.
- Year 5** Year 5 have had another great week. We have been looking at place value in maths, including powers of ten and numbers to a million! We have also enjoyed researching the different rainforest animals and the different features of non-chronological reports. In science, we have tried to clone a plant and have started to look at the life cycles of mammals. Did you know that some mammals lay eggs?

Year 6 Year 6 have been busy this week deepening our knowledge of our book Raven. We have planned our own version of a 'trickster' tale, created our own storymaps and then used these to write our innovated stories. In maths we have been learning more about place value and have revised how to round and order numbers and how to work with negative numbers. As geographers we have investigated climate and how this changes as you move through North America. As artists we have been investigating the native artwork of the Pacific North West and creating our own versions.
